Asahidake Sugatami Area



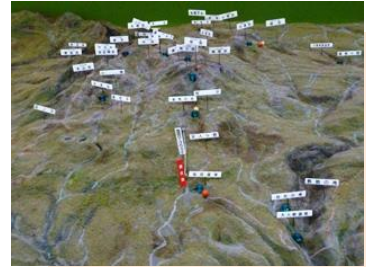

As the weather at the mountain base warms, little snow remains in the pleasantly cool Sugatami area. *Sieversia pentapetala* flowers are reaching their peak and are very beautiful. In addition, over 30 types of plants can be observed, such as *Penstemon frutescens* and *Phyllodoce caerulea*.

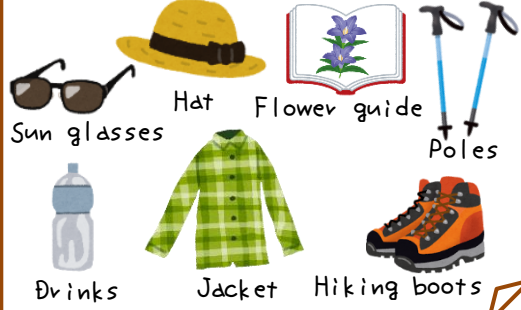
