

The current appearance of the Sugatami Pond area There is a 1.7km pathway at an altitude of 1,600m that is approximately an hour-long walk. Even now, at the end of August, cold winds are already blowing; a sign of autumn. The alpine plants are bearing their fruits. You can encounter animals such as wild birds and Siberian Chipmunks.
