The 1.7km pathway at 1,600m is approximately an hour-long walk. The temperatures dropped at the end of August, and the foliage has started changing colors. You can observe plants such as Solidago virgaurea flowers, and encounter animals such as the Spotted Nutcracker and Siberian Chipmunk. They are now preparing for winter.
