## Sugatami

The whole Trail (1.7km) takes about an hour

The Sugatami Pond and Meoto Pond are now visible as Snow melted quickly due to the temperature increased in recent days. There are unavoidable puddles before and after the snow patch, and water are streaming down between the ropeway station and the Sugatami Pond view point. We recommend wearing rain boots or renting rain boots (300 yen per pair).
